CHRISTMAS COLORS

GOD IS WITH US!!!

Note: Christmas Colors

 There is no Christmas color code in the Bible, of course. However, this is a handy way of teaching the doctrine of Christ to our children as well as reminding ourselves of God this special time of the year.

WHITE:

Reminds us of Light.

"Then Jesus spoke to them again: 'I am the light of the world. Anyone who follows Me will never walk in the darkness but will have the light of life.'" (John 8:12)

BLUE:

Reminds us of Heaven where Jesus came from.

"For I have left Heaven and have come down to earth not to seek my own pleasure, but to do the will of Him who sent me." (John 6:38)

PINK:

Newborn babies are pink colored.

"And the Word came in the flesh, and lived for a time in our midst." (John 1:14)

YELLOW
THE COLOR OF
HAY REMINDS US OF
HIS HUMBLE BIRTH.



Then she gave birth to her firstborn Son, and she wrapped Him snugly in cloth and laid Him in a feeding trough - because there was no room for them at the inn." (Luke 2:7)

GREEN is the color of growing things.

"AND JESUS GREW IN WISDOM AND STATURE, AND IN FAVOR WITH GOD AND MAN."

(Luke 2:52)

GOLD reminds us that Jesus is God. Gold is the color of "divinity". ON COMING TO THE HOUSE, THEY SAW THE CHILD WITH HIS MOTHER MARY, AND THEY BOWED DOWN AND WORSHIPED HIM. THEN THEY **OPENED THEIR TREASURES AND** PRESENTED HIM WITH GIFTS OF **GOLD, FRANKINCENSE AND** MYRRH. (Matthew 2:11)



Silver

- They test silver to prove it's pure.
- Jesus was tempted and proven pure.
- "This High Priest of ours [Jesus] understands our weaknesses, for he faced all of the same temptations we do, yet he did not sin." (Hebrews 4:15)



ORANGE Jesus shines in His righteousness greater than the sun at full blast.

But for you who revere my name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its rays. And you will go out and frolic like well-fed calves. (Mal.4:2)



Purple

- Purple is the color worn by kings.
- "He is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings, and the Lord of lords".

(1 Timothy 6:15)





Red

- Reminds us why He came... to shed His blood on the cross
- Ephesians 1:7 "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace"
